The Annual League Meeting will once again be held **LIVE online on the NCBBA-W Facebook Page**. This meeting is your opportunity to learn more about the latest happenings around the league, understand how the league operates, assure you that the league is headed in the right direction and discuss possible rule changes. Be sure that your team is not left out from learning more about these important topics.

By holding the meeting online, it allows the NCBBA-W to have the greatest reach to all teams and club basketball enthusiasts across the country.
